Mother Marie Jones
(March 12, 1929 -)

HAPPY 94TH BIRTHDAY

Mother Marie Smith Jones is a retired Boeing electrical mock-up engineer, widow, and mother, who has witnessed 34,372 wake-ups. She was born in Shreveport's Caddo Parish into a Creole family with traditional religious values, during Hoover's presidency and just before the Market Crash. Her mom was educated, while her dad worked on the railroad. She graduated high school, secretarial school, and has lived to see World War II up to the War on Ukraine, Jim Crow, Civil Rights Movement, Reagan, Obama, Trump, Covid-19, the first telephone, and bread prices go from 5 cents to \$1.99.

At age 24, she migrated North, joining family members stationed in Seattle's central district in pursuit of a good job and better life. In 1954, she met and married her beloved husband, the late, Willie Jones. They were married for 53 years and stayed together on the foundation of faith, family, love, education, and service.

Notably, Mother Marie has been a member of Tabernacle for 70 years, where she has served as servant leader and member in various ministries including the trustee board, Sunday school, mission department, harvest tea events, usher board, and choir. She attended Edison Technical School and was hired by Boeing in 1956. After serving 38 years and fighting for and winning equal pay, she retired having worked on the B1s, B2s, and 707s – 747s. She has 5 children, 7 grand-children, 11 great-grand-children, 2 great-great-grand-children, and her favorite scripture is Prov 3:5-6.
